WITH GOD

Romans 5:1 "Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God."

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD turn his face toward you and give you peace." **Num 6:24**

The Lord bless (instead of curse) you
and keep (instead of cast you away)
the LORD make his face shine upon you
(rather than His wrath)
and be gracious to you (rather than
exercising judgment).

May the Lord turn his face toward you
(rather than away from you)

and give you peace (rather than dread or
terror).

III. WE HAVE THE PEACE OF GOD BECAUSE OF AN UNWAVERING TRUST IN GOD

Isaiah 26:3

- Trusting that God will not desert us, even when we feel alone
- Resting in God's unmatched power even in the darkest night

- Claiming His forgiveness even when I feel like a failure
- Trusting His wisdom even when I feel foolish
- Being grateful and content even when I don't have what others have knowing that God supplies all my needs
- It means trusting that we can do all things through the Christ who strengthens us even we feel overwhelmed
