



Definitions

- **Motive:** something (such as a need or desire) that causes a person to act
- **Motivation:** the act or process of giving someone a reason for doing something

Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs

Esteem

respect, self-esteem, status, recognition, strength, freedom

Love and belonging

friendship, intimacy, family, sense of connection

Safety needs

personal security, employment, resources, health, property

Physiological needs

air, water, food, shelter, sleep, clothing, reproduction
